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- 1) Welcome and Introductions
 - a. Attendees: Amanda Baltzley, Carol Friedrich, Lance Waring, Mike Bordogna, Ross Valdez, Kathleen Morgan, Delaney Young
- 2) Share current efforts to meet the following needs:
 - a. Carol – Social Services – ESF6
 - i. State approved \$300,000 food to be distributed through food banks
 1. Take 6 weeks to get the food
 - ii. \$500,000 CARES funding available for food pantries – Food Pantry Assistance Grant – Deadline is 7.12 but turnaround pretty quick
 - iii. Pandemic EBT - \$279 benefit per child who was enrolled in free and reduced lunches for the months of March-May
 1. School aged kids 3-22
 2. Benefit will go on the EBT Cards
 3. Easy application with payment made in mid-July
 4. White EBT card that says CO EBT – different from normal card
 5. Benefit going at least until next school year enrollment
 - iv. Free Cloth Face masks available through state emergency operations
 1. Need to order through Carol
 2. For local governments, local non-profits, etc...
 - v. Non-Congregate sheltering extended for another 30 days
 1. Have had food support for isolated families
 2. FEMA also approved sheltering for non-COVID events as well (Fires, floods, etc...) – Red Cross would be running – through FEMA PA Fund
 3. Still have contracts with Alpine, Montrose and working with a hotel in Ouray
 - vi. DOLA – Funding available for housing and rehousing
 1. Counties need to be looking at homeless population
 2. Most funding is short term housing but need to review long term housing
 3. Carol to look through housing funds and share appropriate ones with the group
 - vii. West End – Michelle Blunt
 1. No school lunch programs being offered in Norwood
 - a. 20 total kids through school year
 2. Food Security meeting – 7/9 for Norwood
 - viii. Mental Health Sub-group meeting
 1. Substance abuse, treatments, interventions for teens and adults
 2. Intensive out-patient treatment –
 - a. Out-patient - 0-8 hours a week
 - b. Intensive out-patient – 9+ hour

- c. Looking at programs to increase services for substance abuse
 - ix. Senior Lunches
 - 1. Home Delivered meals program ending
 - 2. Christ Presbyterian church – July 20 to have their garden open for seniors – open to several days a week
 - a. Can serve up to 50 people and willing to do it 3 times a week
 - i. Is there funding and can restaurants support?
 - ii. Maybe grab and go
 - iii. Weather permitting
 - b. Region 10 – to see if there is money to pay the restaurants
- b. Lance
 - i. Lighthouse and Shepherd Hand in Montrose
 - 1. Overwhelmed – no volunteers, losing food resources, Lighthouse is closed due to COVID and no hotel accommodations
 - 2. Maybe good to get them info on the food grants
 - 3. Carol will share concern with resources in Montrose
- c. Kathleen Morgan – made about 1,000 masks
 - i. Supplied to pre-school
 - ii. Looking at helping stockpile for schools
- d. Mike Bordogna
 - i. Communications group – missed portions of population that need targeted communications?
 - 1. Parents of kids not enrolled in SNAP – Pandemic EBT opportunity – Carol
 - 2. School lunches program - Ross
 - ii. CARES Act money being worked through with the county and Telluride and MV
- e. Ross
 - i. School lunches – 22 kids participating
 - 1. Potentially reinventing that program
 - 2. Discussing a backpack program, maybe pick-up at food bank on Friday
 - ii. Latinx website – proposal to Lance, Adrienne, Natalie, Marty
 - 1. Progressing – getting feedback from members and moving forward
- f. Delaney
 - i. No info right now on housing relief fund – may have exhausted fund if no new donations – discussion tomorrow in Town Council meeting
 - 1. New work displacement because of new cases and PPP has run out
 - 2. Worried about housing aspect but encouraged about food
 - ii. Senate Bill 222 – additional \$20 million for state businesses – priority rural, minority owned, and people who didn't qualify for PPP
