APPENDIX G: EXEMPTION REQUESTS

The key elements of the Order are that most people still stay at home as much as possible and avoid unnecessary social interactions; vulnerable populations continue to stay at home except to support or perform necessary activities or participate in critical government functions or critical businesses; certain business operations are permitted; people are still encouraged to stay within their county of residence or employment as much as possible; public gatherings of more than ten (10) persons are prohibited; and individuals are advised to wear non-medical cloth face coverings that cover the nose and mouth whenever in public.

Individuals, businesses or services that desire to apply for an exemption from part or all of this Order may do so after meeting the following criteria and submitting an alternative COVID-19 suppression plan to be approved or denied by the Public Health Director or her designee.

Criteria for exemption considerations for specific businesses or industries will be added to the San Miguel County COVID-19 website under "Resources for Businesses".
