**TO ALL SAN MIGUEL COUNTY VOTERS**

The **PRIMARY** Election on  
Tuesday, June 30, 2020 will be conducted as  
**All Mail Delivery of Ballots under HB13-1303.**

State residency is required as of June 8, 2020 in order to vote on  
Federal, State and County races and issues.

The last day to affiliate with a party to receive that party's primary ballot is June 1, 2020.  
Unaffiliated voters without a preference will receive both party's ballots, though they must choose  
just **one** to vote and return.

Registration may be up to Election Day.

Ballots will be mailed June 8, 2020 and must be received by the County Clerk by  
7:00 p.m. on Election Day, June 30, 2020. Postmarks do not count.

Voter registration, issue of original ballots or replacements, in person voting and change of voter  
address, and ballot drop-off, etc., are available at:

The same services will also be available on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the  
Town of Norwood Town Hall

Voting by electronic machine is available at the above locations and hours.

The San Miguel County Courthouse at 305 West Colorado in Telluride is not an ADA accessible  
location but most services, excluding electronic voting machines, will be available there until  
Election Day.

On Election Day go to the County Annex at 335 West Colorado.

**On Election Day only Motor Vehicle Services will be available at the County Courthouse.**  
**Recording and Marriage Licenses will be closed.**
