The 2022 Primary Election is on June 28, 2022 and the General Election is November 8, 2022 and judges are needed for Ballot Dropbox Pickups and Voter Service and Polling Centers.

Judges are paid \$16/hour for all shifts, including required online and in person training. For details and to apply, please email elections@sanmiguelcountyco.gov

Did you know that while Colorado County Clerks serve as the Election Official, bipartisan teams of registered Colorado voters serve as judges who maintain all services at Polling Centers, validate signatures and tabulate the ballots?

Elections are a community effort, and San Miguel County is in need of Election Judges for the upcoming 2022 Election Cycle.

Interested parties should have the following qualifications in order to serve as a judge:

- B**e registered to vote in the state of Colorado*
- N**ot a candidate or family member of a candidate on the ballot*
- P**ass a Colorado Bureau of Investigation background check*
- W**ork as a team with a group of bipartisan neighbors and community members*
- F**ollow very specific direction and abide by all legal requirements pertaining to election conduct*
- B**asic knowledge of computers, ability to learn and use the statewide registration system*
- A**bility to sit and/or stand for long hours(judge shifts range from 4-13 hours)*
- A** desire to contribute to the goal of providing fair, transparent and secure elections in San Miguel County*
- A**bility to complete required online and in person training provided by Colorado Secretary of State and San Miguel County Clerk*
